THE SEVENTH GILMAN RUTIHINDA MEMORIAL LECTURE

This is to inform the general public that the Bank of Tanzania will hold its 7th Gilman Rutihinda Memorial Lecture (GRML) on 10th June 2014 from 2.00pm to 5.00pm at the Bank of Tanzania Conference Center.

The Gilman Rutihinda Memorial Lecture is held every two years in honour of the Late Gilman Rutihinda, the third Governor of the Bank of Tanzania. The series of these lectures was launched in June 1995 in recognition of Gilman Rutihinda's outstanding contribution to the economy and particularly to the financial sector. The lecture brings together policy makers, academicians and other players to exchange views and experiences on public policy issues of interest to our economy.

The theme of the 7th GRML will be "Gains from the Natural Gas: Local Content and Tanzania's Industrial Development" and will be delivered by Prof. John Sutton from the London School of Economics.
