NOTICE TO DEPOSITORS, CREDITORS AND DEBTORS

Following BANK OF TANZANIA's revocation of banking business license for Covenant Bank For Women (Tanzania) Limited, Efatha Bank Limited, Njombe Community Bank Limited, Kagera Farmers' Cooperative Bank Limited and Meru Community Bank Limited (the banks) and subsequent appointment of the DEPOSIT INSURANCE BOARD (DIB) as the Liquidator effective from 4th January 2018; Depositors, Creditors and Debtors of the banks are advised to be patient as the Liquidator puts in place arrangements to handle their affairs. The Liquidator shall, in due course, inform depositors, creditors and debtors on payout plan, debt collection and other similar arrangements in line with the provisions of the law.
