

MWALIMU JULIUS NYERERE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

BRIEF INFORMATION ON SCHOLARSHIP, BENEFICIARIES, APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Brief history of the Mwalimu Nyerere Memorial Scholarship Fund

In commemorating the great achievements of the Father of our Nation Mwalimu Julius K. Nyerere, on 12th October, 2009 the Bank of Tanzania established an Endowment Fund known as “Mwalimu Julius Nyerere Memorial Scholarship Fund”. The Fund is primarily dedicated for sponsoring top undergraduate female students to pursue Mathematics and Science studies in Tanzanian accredited universities. The Fund also sponsors male Tanzanians to pursue undergraduate studies in Mathematics, Science, Economics, Information Technology, Accounting and Finance. In addition, the Fund sponsors both male and female best Tanzanians students to undertake Master’s Degree Programmes in the afore mentioned fields of study.

2. General Scholarship Information:

The fund invites applications scholarships annually i.e. after issuance of examination results for advanced Secondary School Education examination by the National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA). The Fund scholarships cover full tuition fee, stipend allowance, field allowance, research funds and one laptop computer. Selected applicants are required to forfeit any other loan or bursary arrangements provided for the same study course and year.

3. Selection Criteria:

(i) Undergraduate Studies Scholarship Selection Criteria

a) Mathematics or Science Category

Applications for Scholarships under this sub-category are for female applicants only and applicants must meet the following criteria: -

- i.* Must be a female Tanzanian citizen who has completed Advanced Level Secondary School Education in the same year of application;
- ii.* Must be among the top female best performers in Mathematics or Science subjects in Advanced Level Secondary School education examinations;
- iii.* Must have secured admission into one of the accredited Tanzanian universities or other recognized higher learning institutions to pursue undergraduate studies on a full time basis in the field of Mathematics or Science.

b) Mathematics, Science, Economics, Information Technology, Accounting or Finance category

Applications for Scholarships under this sub category are open to both male and female students and applicants must meet the following criteria: -

- i. Must be a Tanzanian citizen who has completed Advanced Level Secondary School Education in the same year of application;
- ii. Must be among the top best performers in Mathematics, Science, Economics, Commerce and Accounting subjects in the Advanced Level Secondary School examinations;
- iii. Must have secured admission in one of the Tanzanian accredited universities or other recognized higher learning institutions to pursue undergraduate studies on a full time basis in the field of Mathematics, Science, Economics, Information Technology, Accounting or Finance.

c) Selection Criteria for Graduate Studies Master's Degree in Studies related to Mathematics, Science, Economics, Information Technology, Accounting and Finance.

An applicant for a Scholarship under this category shall be required to meet the following criteria:

- i. Must be a Tanzanian citizen who has completed a bachelor degree in studies related to Mathematics, Science, Economics, Information Technology, Accounting and Finance with minimum GPA of 4.0;
- ii. Must be among the top best performers at undergraduate level;
- iii. Must have secured admission at a Tanzanian university or other recognized higher learning institution to pursue a Master degree on a full time basis in the fields of Mathematics, Science, Economics, Information Technology, Accounting or Finance.
- iv. Must have completed Bachelor degree program within a maximum of three years; and
- v. Should not be more than thirty-five years old.
